Today we commemorated Kokoda Day, the 81st anniversary of the raising of the Australian flag over Kokoda village during the WWII campaign.


Three veterans of that war were able to be present and participate: Bruce Robertson, Reg Chard and David Trist laid wreaths and were applauded for their service.
